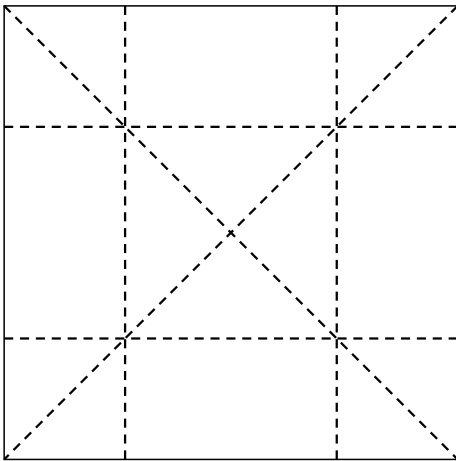


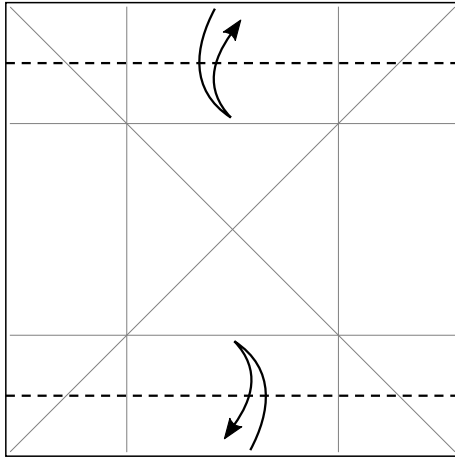

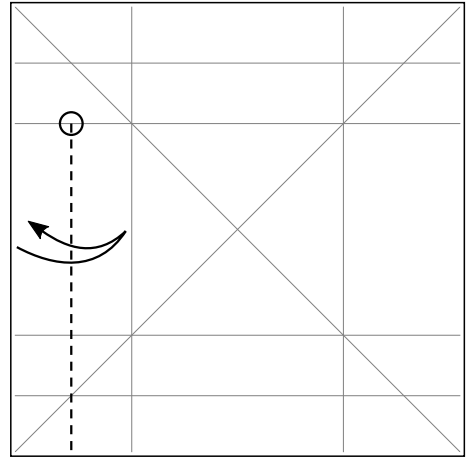
Crease the 4/15 Base.

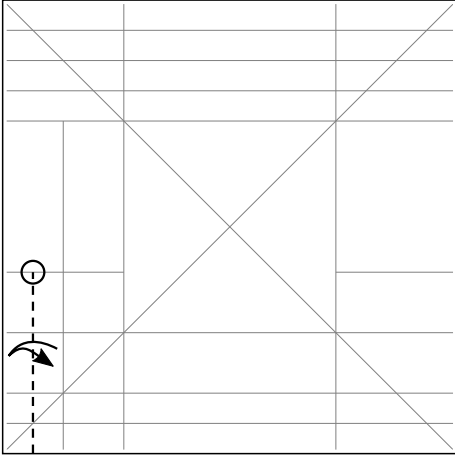

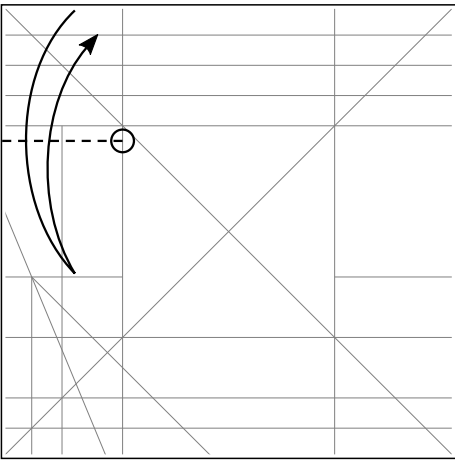

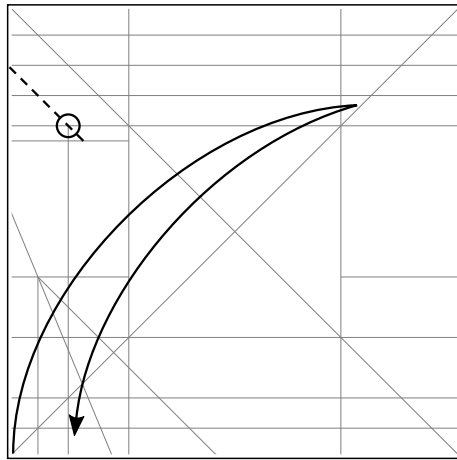

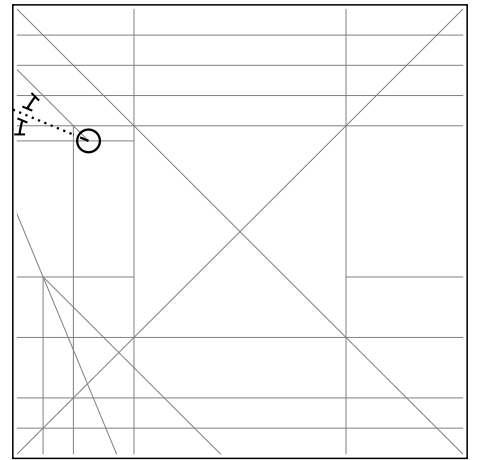

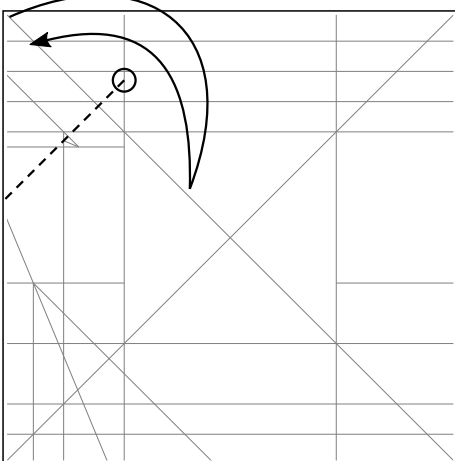

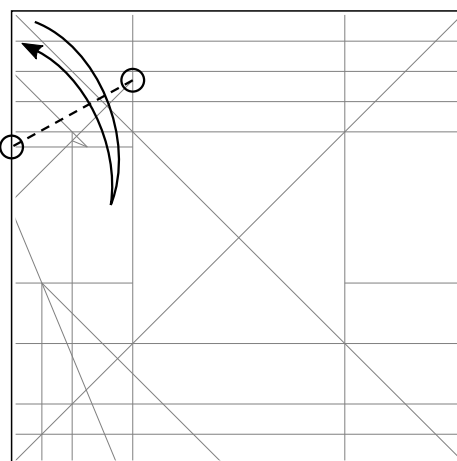

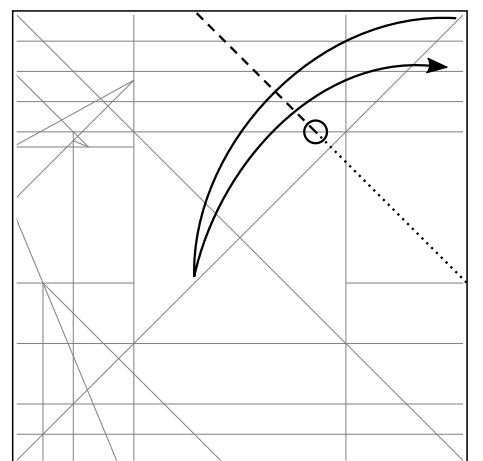

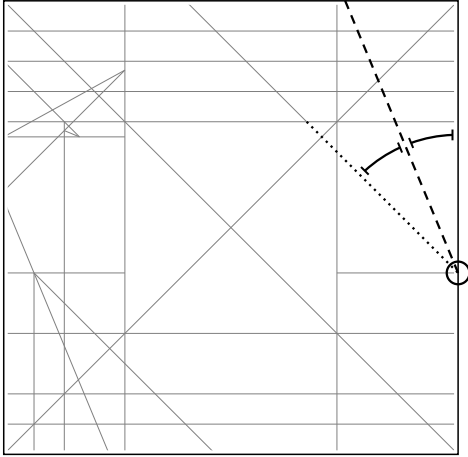

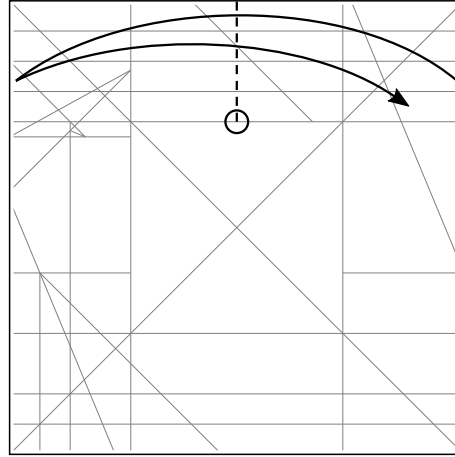

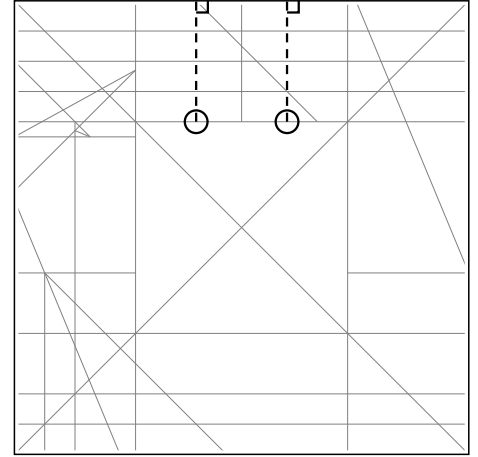

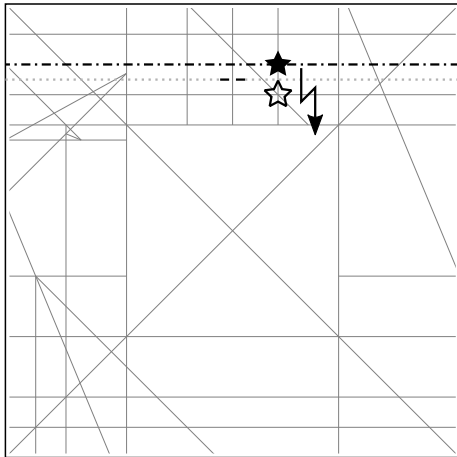
Bring the edge to the edge and crease up to the circled point.

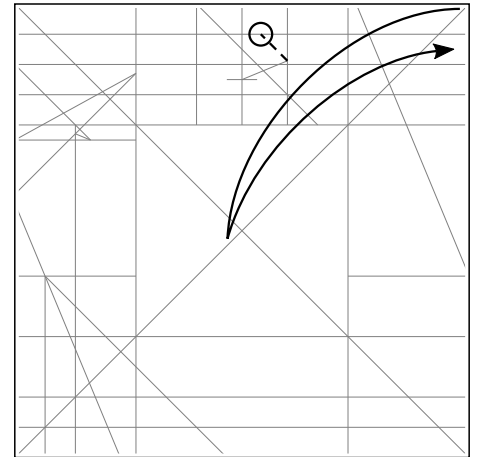

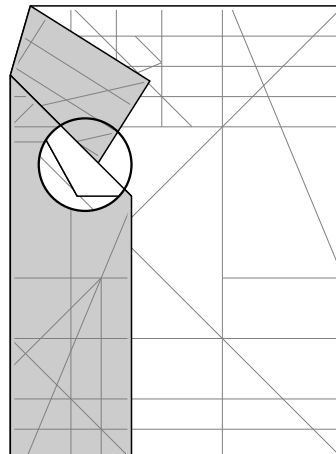

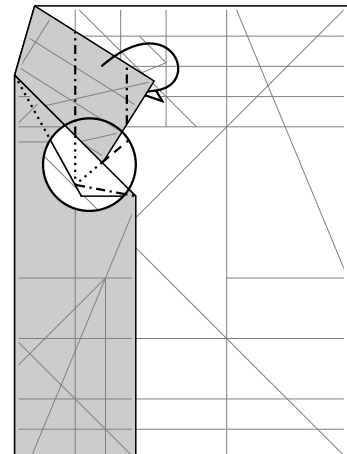
Collapse along three existing creases and one new crease.

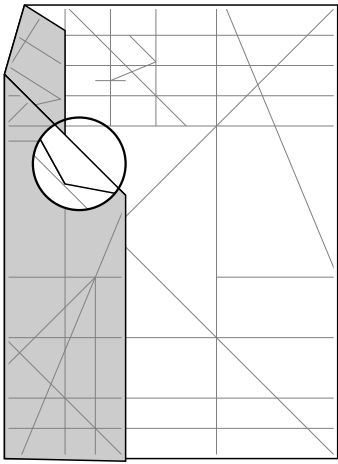
X-ray view.

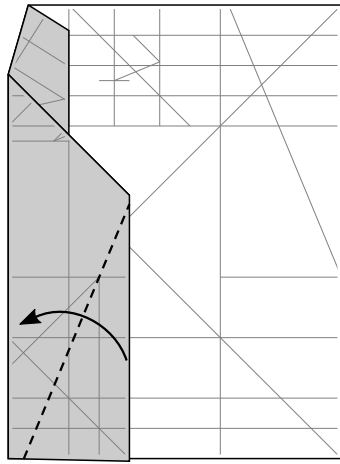
Swivel-fold inward, lining up the fold with the crease behind. The tip will bend a little. Fold it away.

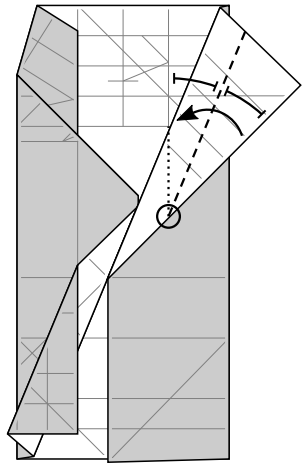

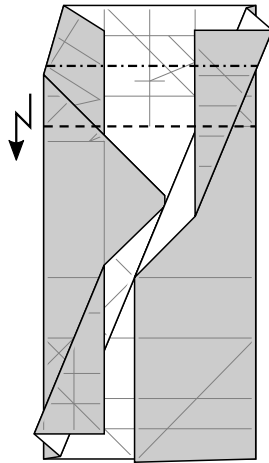

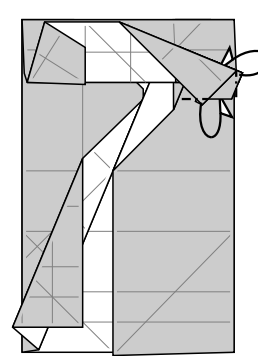

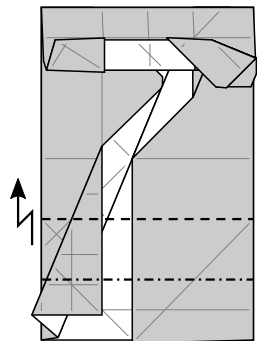
